



SY 20-21 Proposed Price Increase and Procedural Changes

- I. Child Nutrition Paid Lunch Price Increases: As required by State Department of Education- Child Nutrition Program
 - a. Elementary Schools will go from \$2.92 to \$3.00
 - b. Intermediate School lunches will go from \$2.92 to \$3.00
 - c. Middle School lunches will go from \$2.92 to \$3.00
 - d. High School lunches will go from \$3.25 to \$3.35
 - e. Adult lunches at all sites will go \$3.84 to \$3.94
 - f. Reduced lunches at all sites will be \$0.40

- II. Child Nutrition Paid Breakfast Price Increases:
 - a. Paid Breakfast at all sites will go from \$1.75 to \$1.85
 - b. Adult Breakfast at all sites will go \$2.00 to \$2.10
 - c. Reduced Breakfast at all sites will be \$0.30

- III. District Allowable Negative Balances Amounts: Requires to be updated since the lunch prices would be increasing.
 - a. Lunches can be charged up to the following amounts:
 - i. Elementary Schools up to \$15.00
 - ii. Intermediate School up to \$15.00
 - iii. Middle School up to \$15.00
 - iv. High School up to \$16.75

- IV. Procedural Changes:
 - a. Effective August 13th 2020, once a student has met the district allowable negative balance amount (charge amount), an alternative lunch will be served. The lunch will be a cheese sandwich, a fruit or vegetable and milk. This meal meets all School Nutrition requirements for a reimbursable meal.
 - b. Effective August 13th 2020 No Ala Carte food items may be purchased by anyone with a zero or negative food service account balance.
 - c. These policies are in place as a continued effort to reduce the total negative account balances in Deer Creek Public Schools.
