

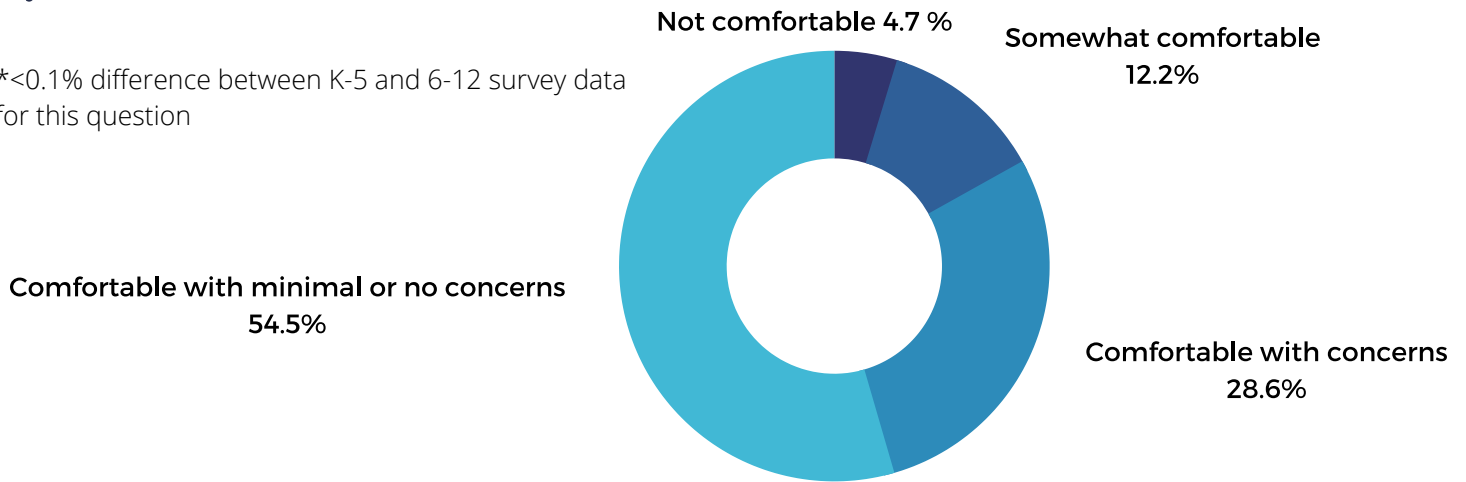

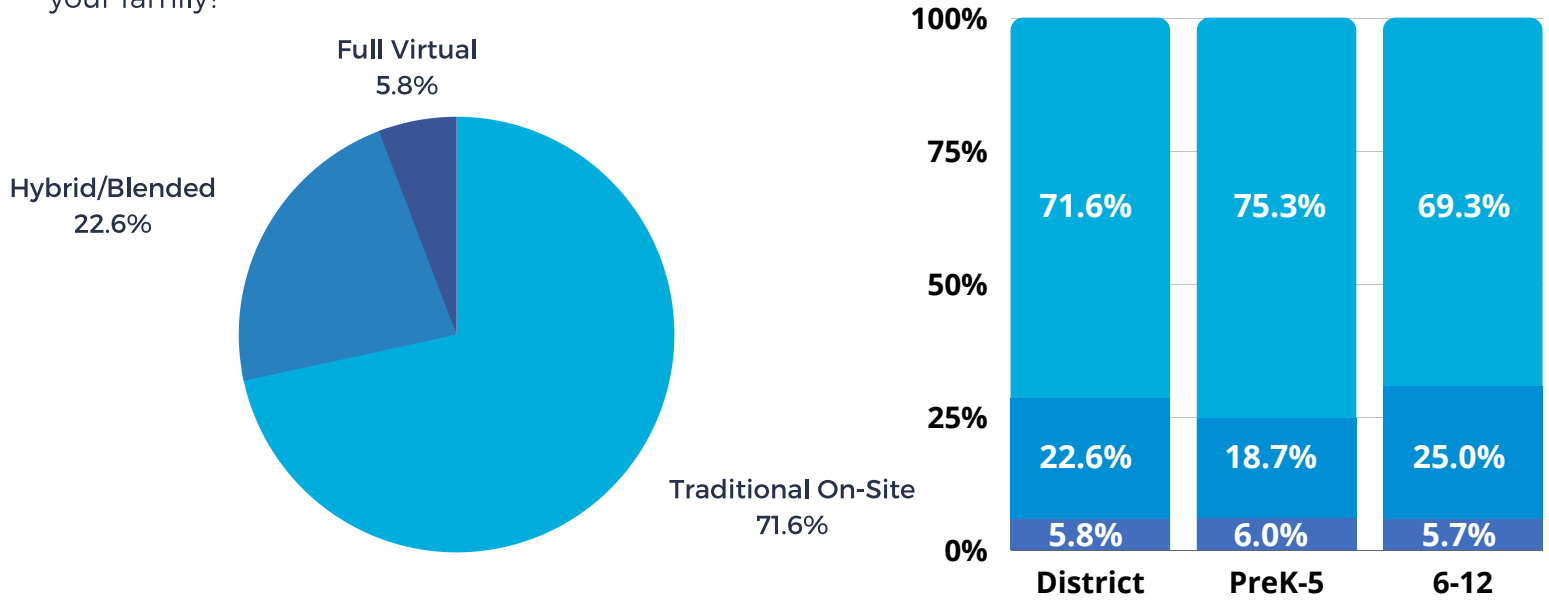
If public officials believe it is safe to allow in-person instruction, would you be comfortable having your student return to school this fall?

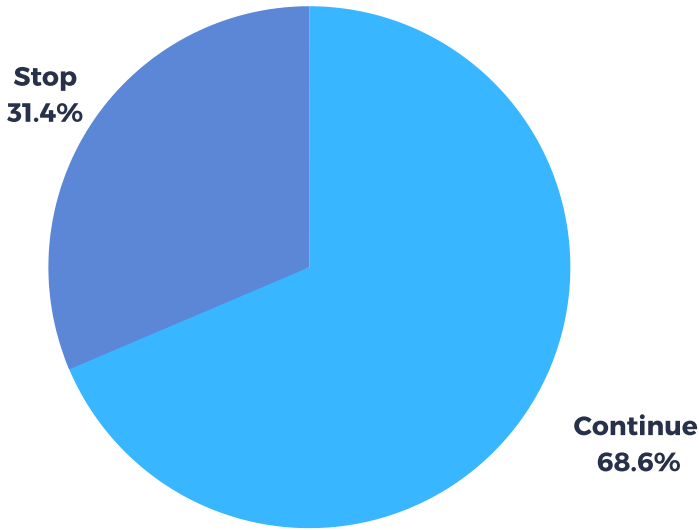

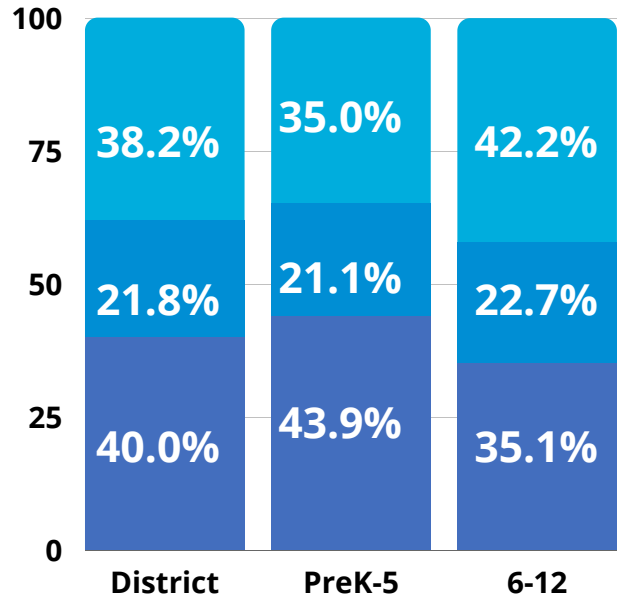
### GRADE BAND RESULTS:

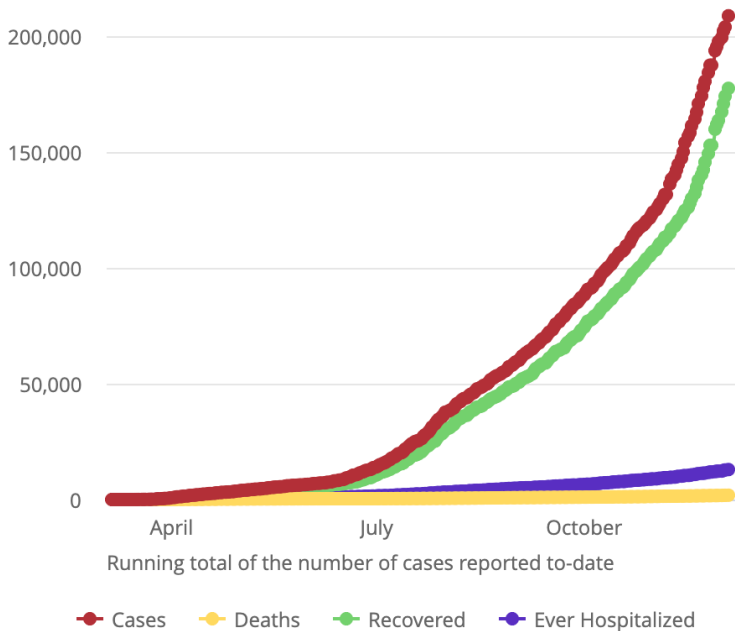

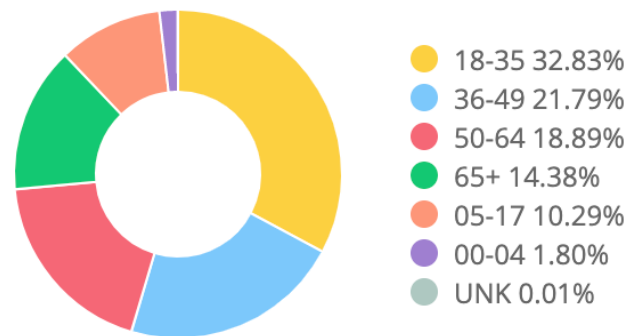
